

Redefining of Existing vision and mission of the college.

Summary of Discussion: -

- Dr. Pradeep C., Principal introduced college infrastructure, human resource to the advisory committee members. He has also highlighted present vision and mission statements of the college. He has requested to Prof. Bibin Thomas- Assistant Professor, Verbal and Language Trainer of the Placement Cell to initiate the discussion.
- Prof. Bibin Thomas- Assistant Professor, Verbal and Language Trainer of the Placement Cell
 introduced and outlined options for the committee regarding consultation on the revised
 vision and mission
- Sri. Roy V. Vairamon- Director, MBCCET, Peermade suggested that the vision and mission statement needs to be more succinct therefore initially we have to examine on that to make revisions.
- 4. Prof. Dr. M.P. Mathai- Governing Board member, MBCCET, Peermade, has expressed the multiple aspects that teaching, learning, research and community outreach service so it should be incorporated in the mission such that the students should be educated with latest technological aspects to become more employable.
- Sri. Sajan George- Governing Board member, Industrialist, MBCCET, Peermade, said that all
 the faculty should learn and get updated with current technology aspects, only then
 department as a whole will be able to function as a hub for feeding updated technology for
 our students.

- 10. Prof. Robins Anto, HOD EEE has discussed to develop the good habits of self-discipline, attitude among the students & organize the debate on Industry- Academic Institute interaction.
- 11. Er.Deepak T- Alumni(2007-2011), Assistant Engineer, KSEB has insisted to encourage & motivate students as per area of student's interest. Also it is requiring to develop problem solving ability among the students.
