1. The report and the minutes of the previous meeting held on 24.2.2018 were read and passed by Ms. Josmy George and seconded by Dr. Nirmala Joseph.
2. The students suggested the need of computers and printer in hostels to use on Sundays and holidays.
3. The students suggested the installation of fans in MH₂.
4. The students of MH pointed out the need of water filters in all floors of M.
5. The students of LH pointed out that Wi-Fi gets disconnected frequently and should take steps to avoid that.
6. The students suggested to increase the capacity of water heater / provide additional water heater in MH₁ and MH₂.
7. The 4th year students suggested to make them available in Wi-Fi connection in college during project hours.

8. The students of Ladies Hostel suggested to take measures to improve the quality and quantity of mess.
9. The students requested to take measures to level the bike shed and increase its length (if possible).
10. Some students pointed out that it is better to avoid dogs in and around College campus.
11. Students pointed out that the installation of fans in S₅ ME class is a must.
12. The students of S₁ CE, S₁ EEE and S₅ ECE suggested to put curtains ~~adopting~~ proper method in their classrooms, since sunlight make them difficult to view the board clearly.
13. The students of MH₁ pointed out that some rooms (Room No. 218, 219, 211 etc.) don't have the proper facility to lock.
14. The students of MH suggested to clean the drainage behind the hostel and avoid bad smell.
