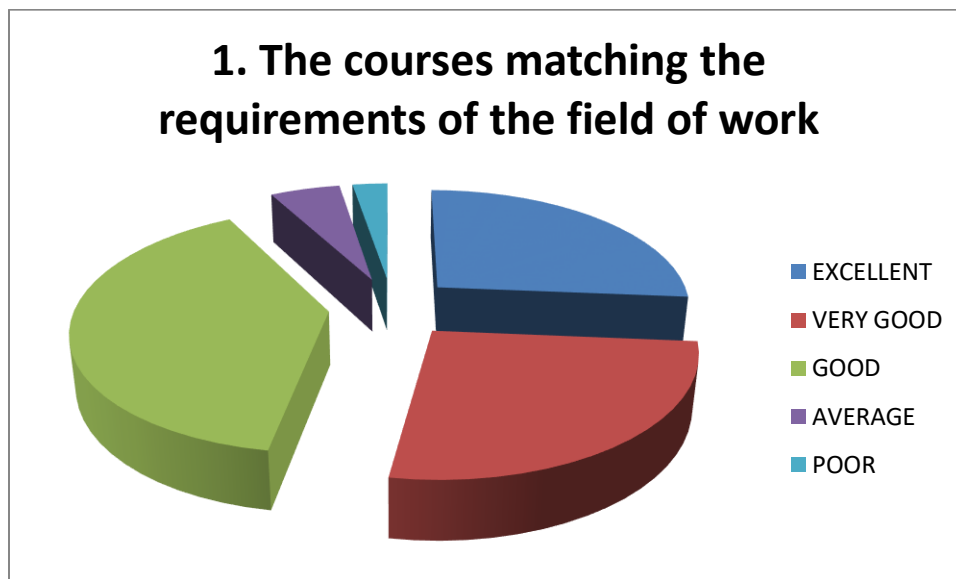


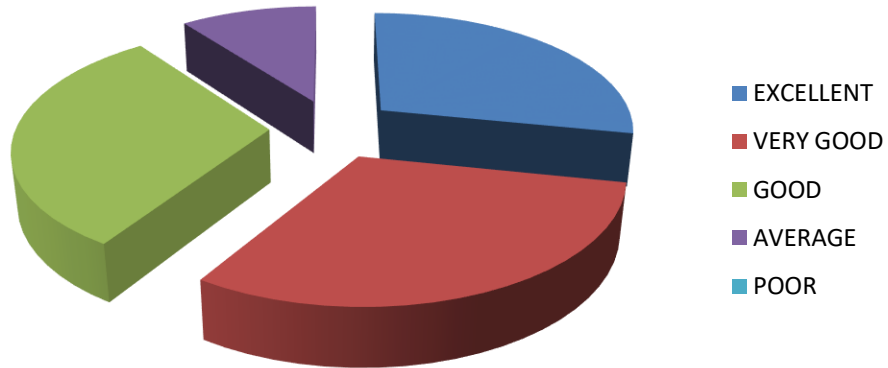
ALUMNI FEEDBACK REPORT 2023-24

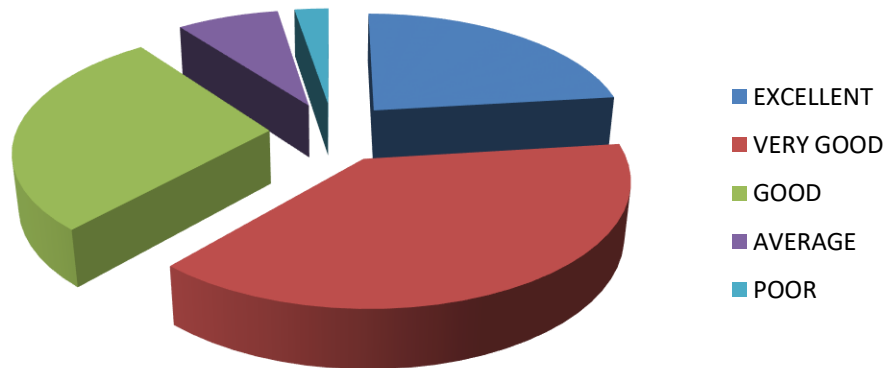

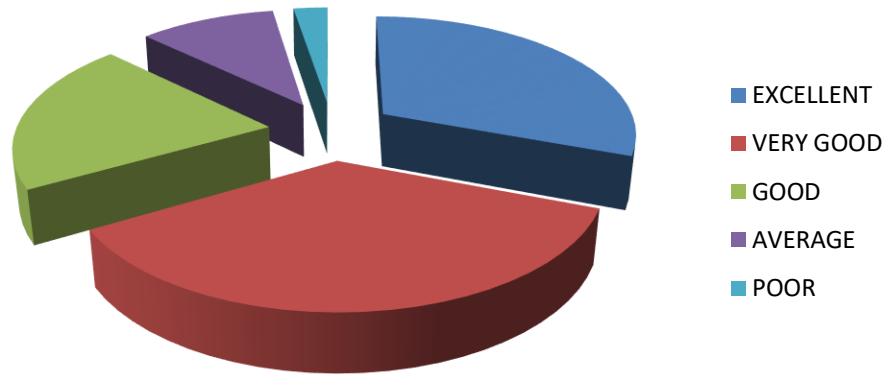

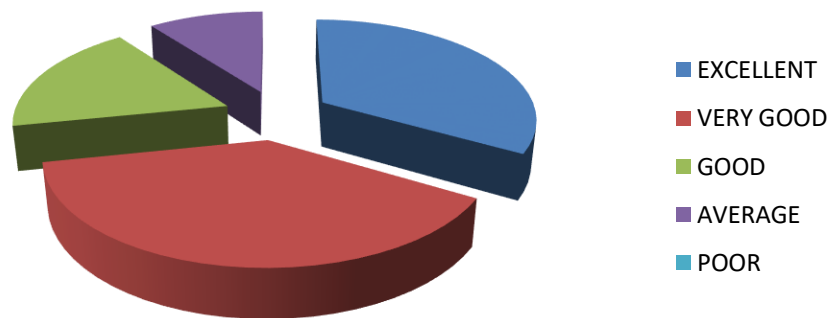
3. Courses that helped in developing your personality



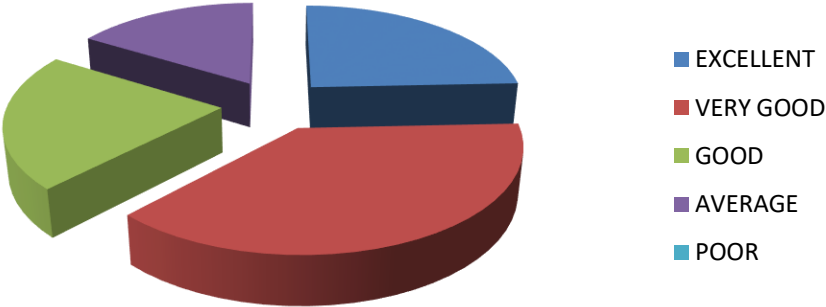
4. Confidence level in your profession having undergone the program



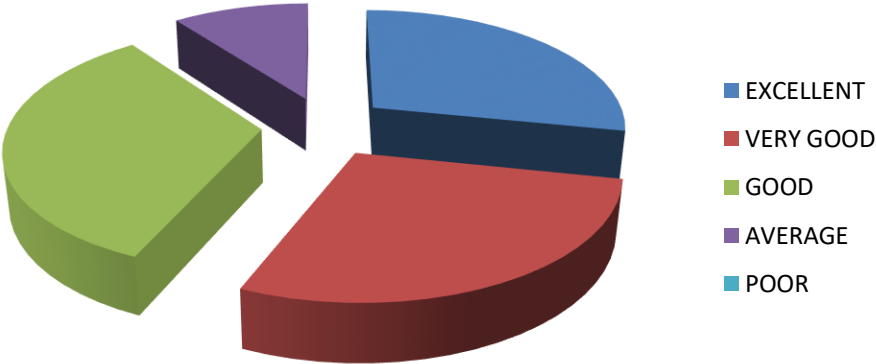
5. The program helped to mould you to address health, legal, safety, cultural and societal issues



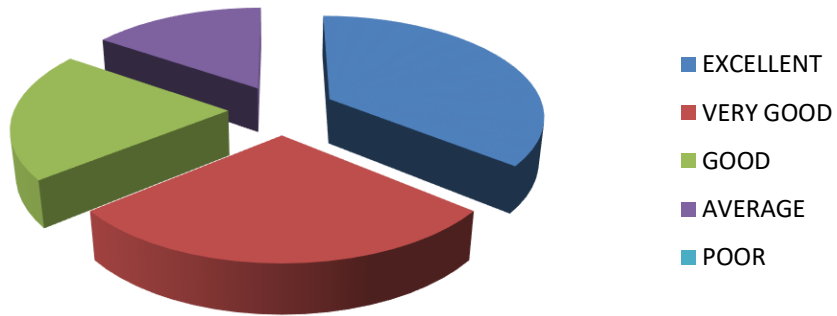

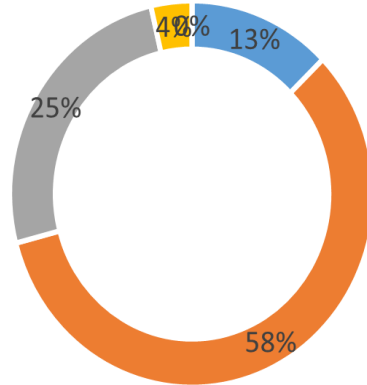
FACULTY FEEDBACK REPORT 2023-2024

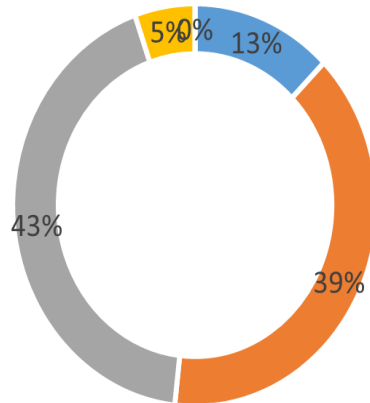


QUALITY AND RELEVANCE OF THE COURSES IN THE CURRICULUM



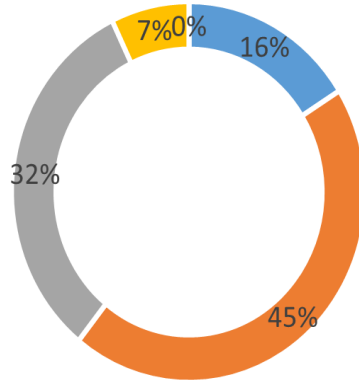

COURSES OFFERED ARE IN RELEVANCE TO THE LATEST AND/OR THE FUTURE TECHNOLOGIES



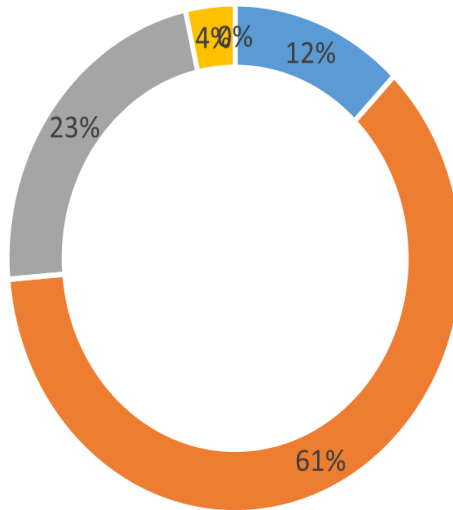

NUMBER OF SUBJECTS THAT INCULCATING ETHICS, VALUES AND SOCIETAL NEEDS



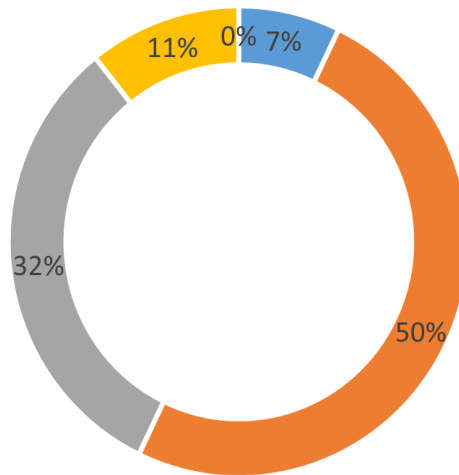

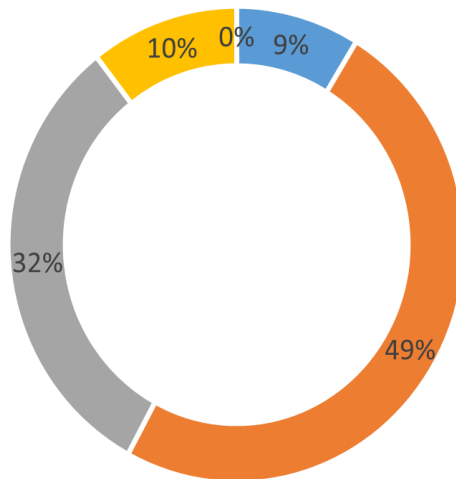

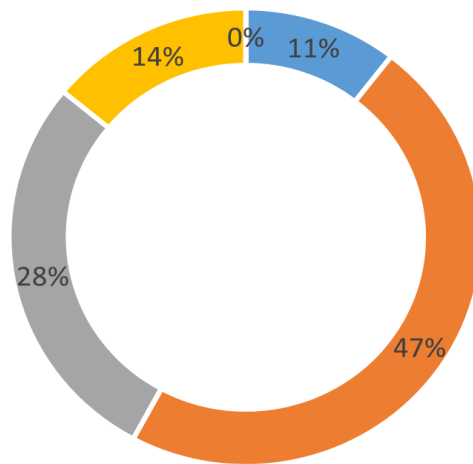

ALLOCATION OF THE CREDITS TO THE COURSES



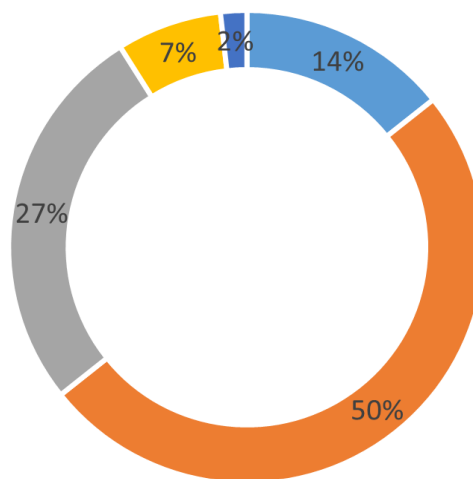

ADDITION OF INTERNSHIP PROGRAM IN THE CURRICULUM FOR INDUSTRY EXPOSURE



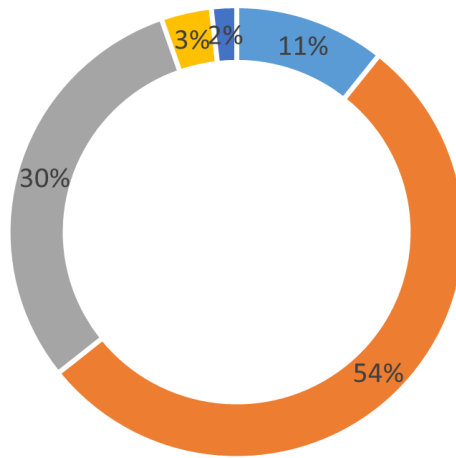

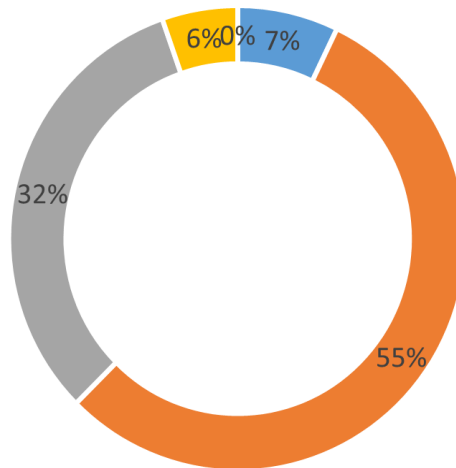

RELEVANCE OF THE TEXT AND REFERENCE BOOKS REFERRED IN THE SYLLABUS



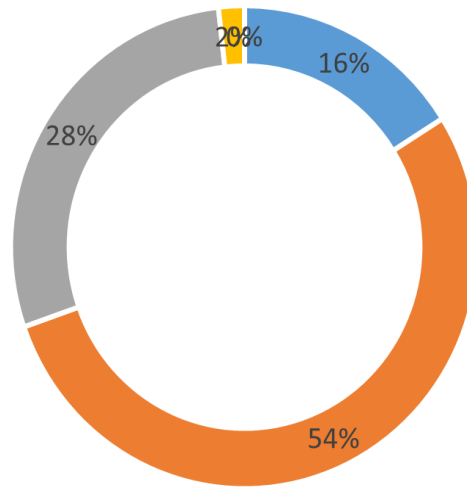

THE SYLLABUS OF THE COURSES IN RELATION TO THE EXPECTED COMPETENCIES



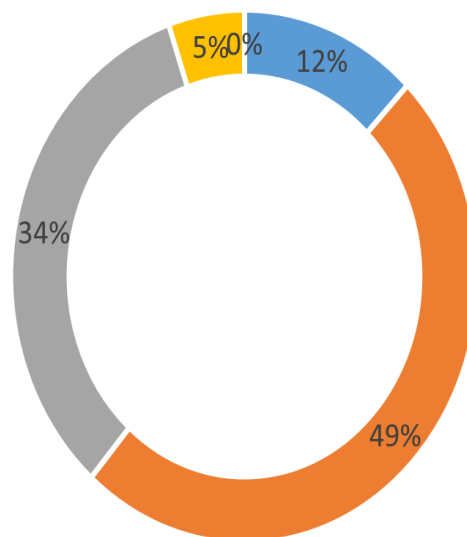

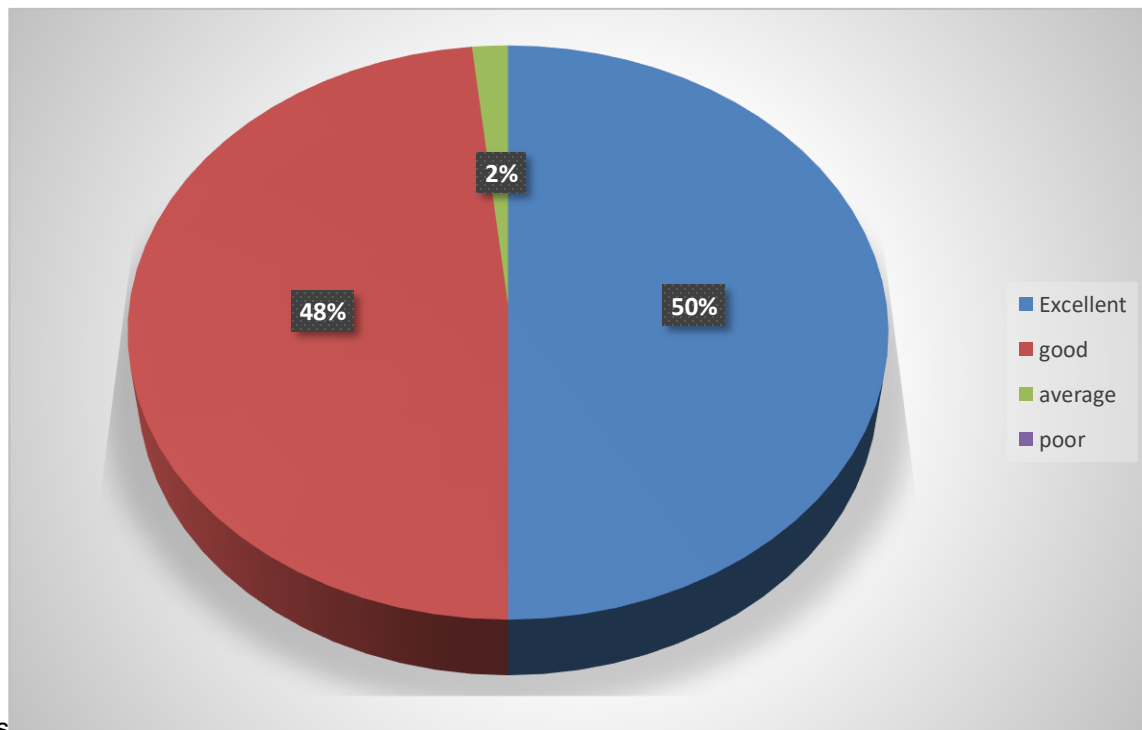
PARENTS FEEDBACK REPORT 2022-2024

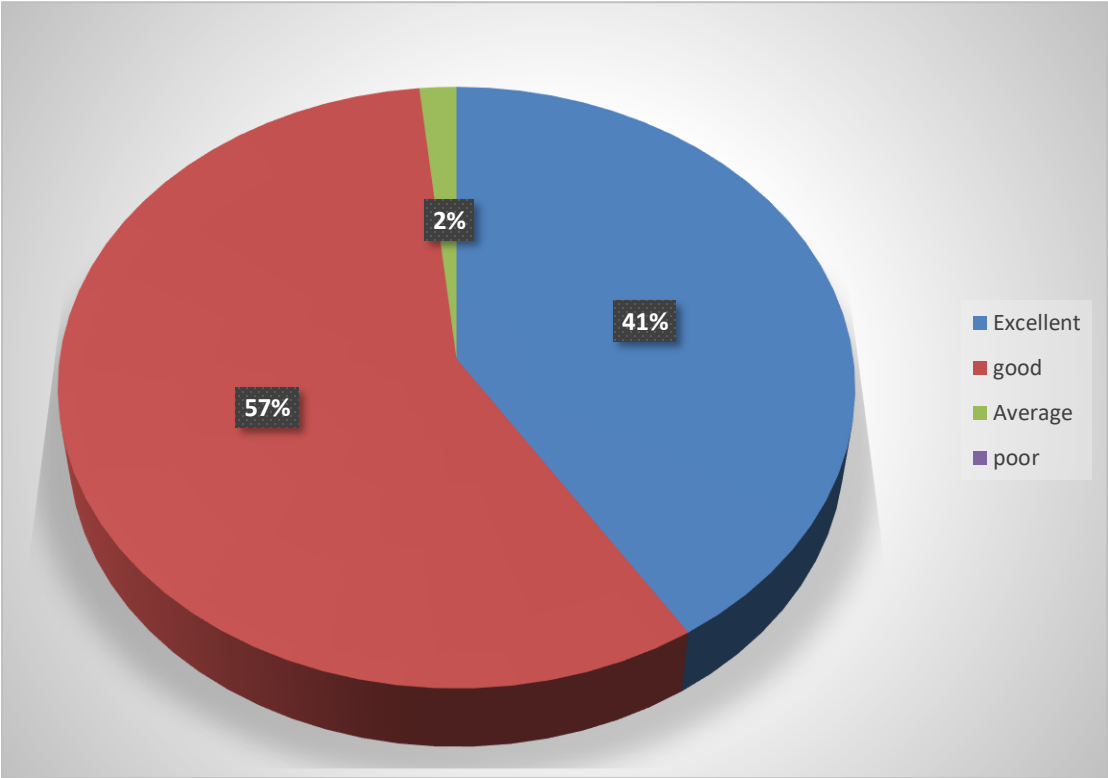

Around which 60%excellent, 45% good,5% average noted during the survey.

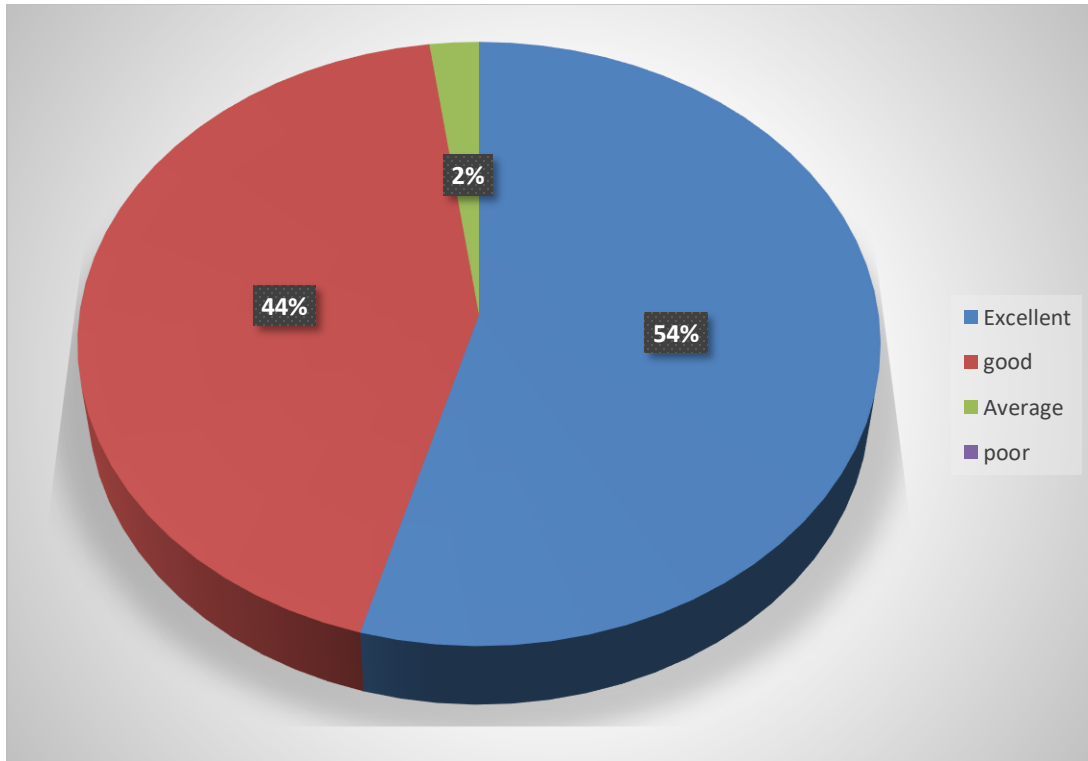

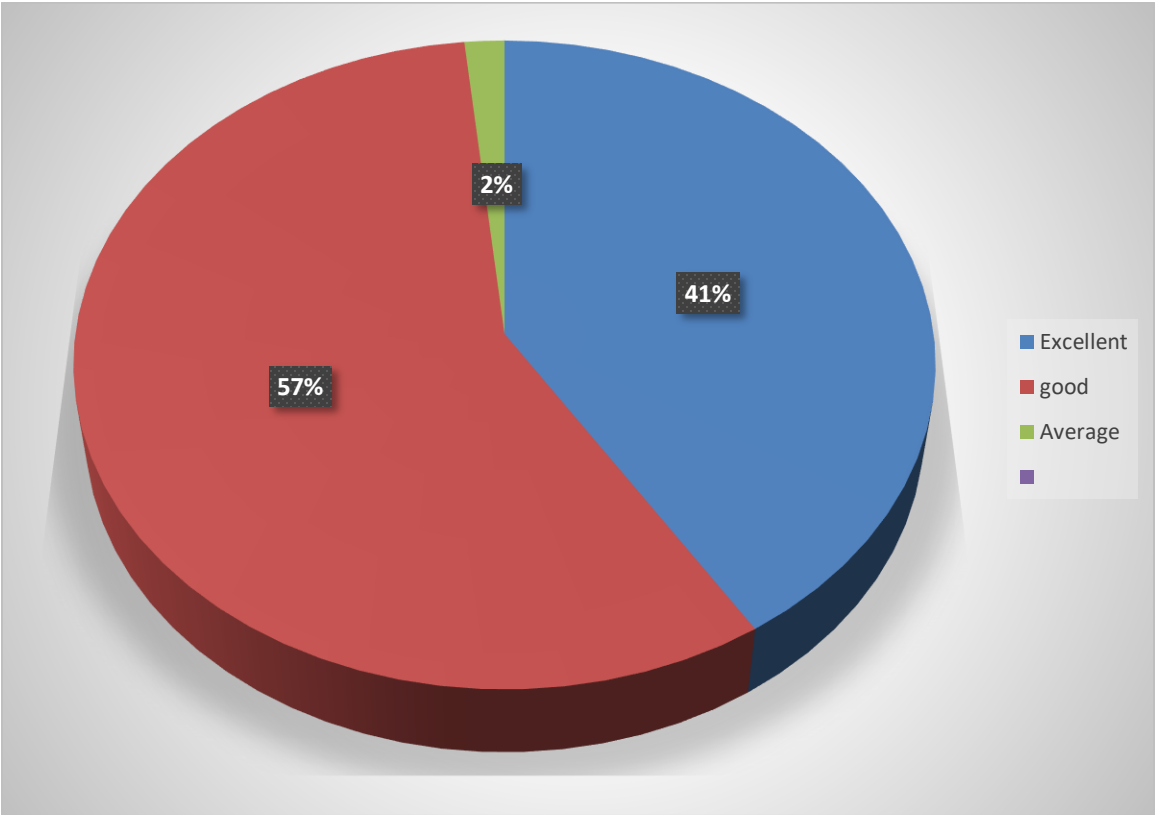

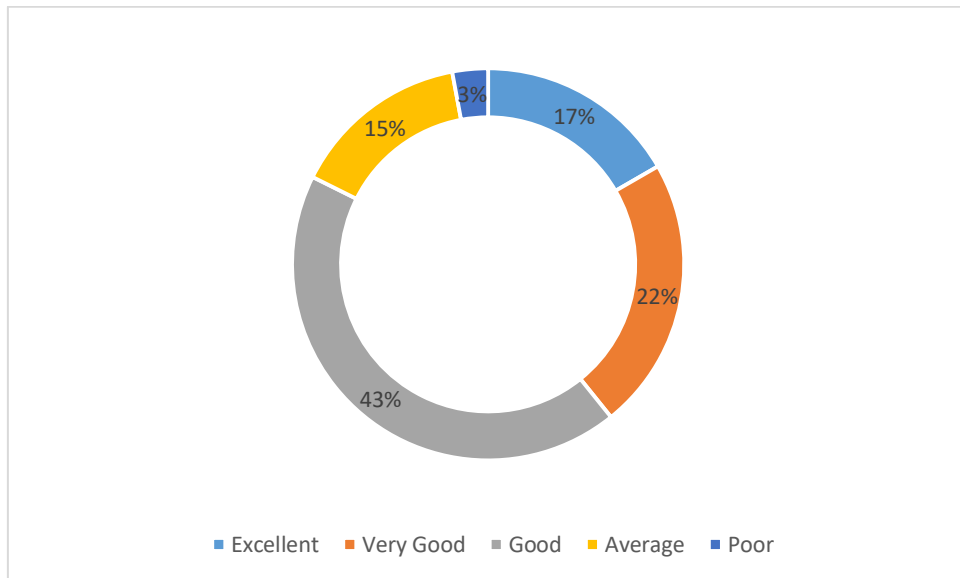
STUDENTS FEEDBACK REPORT 2023-2024

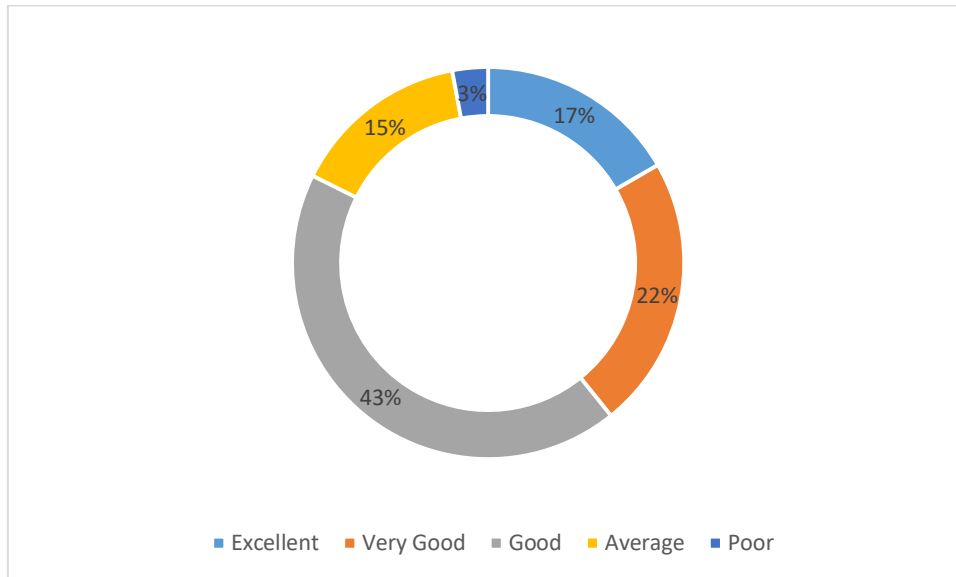
The syllabus of the courses in relation to the competencies/ expected outcomes



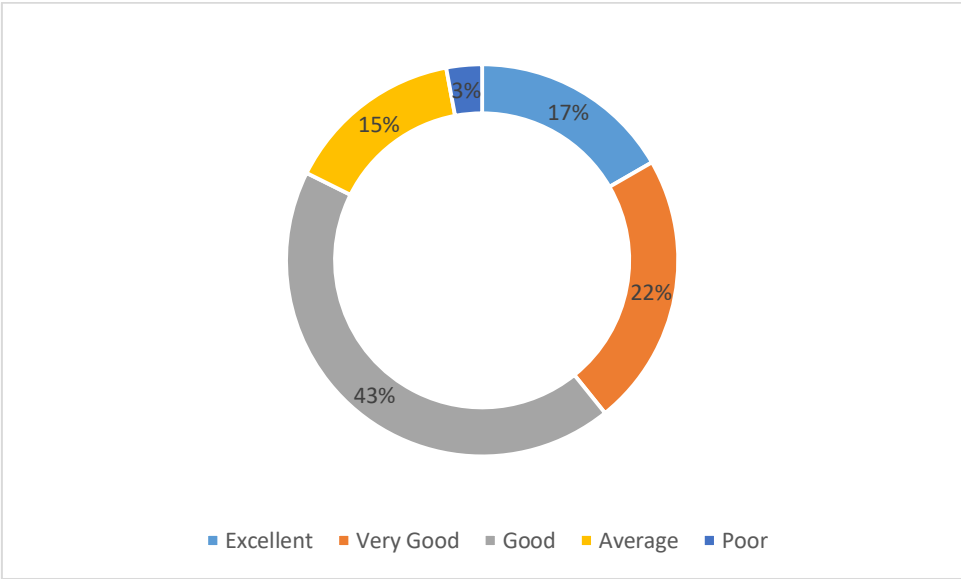
Relevance of the modules in the course



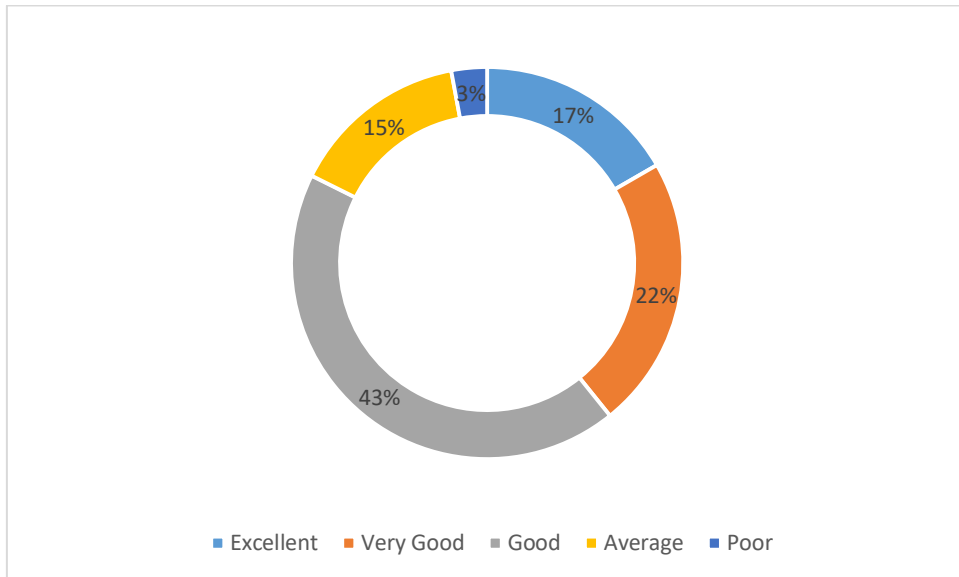
Distribution of the contact hours among the course components



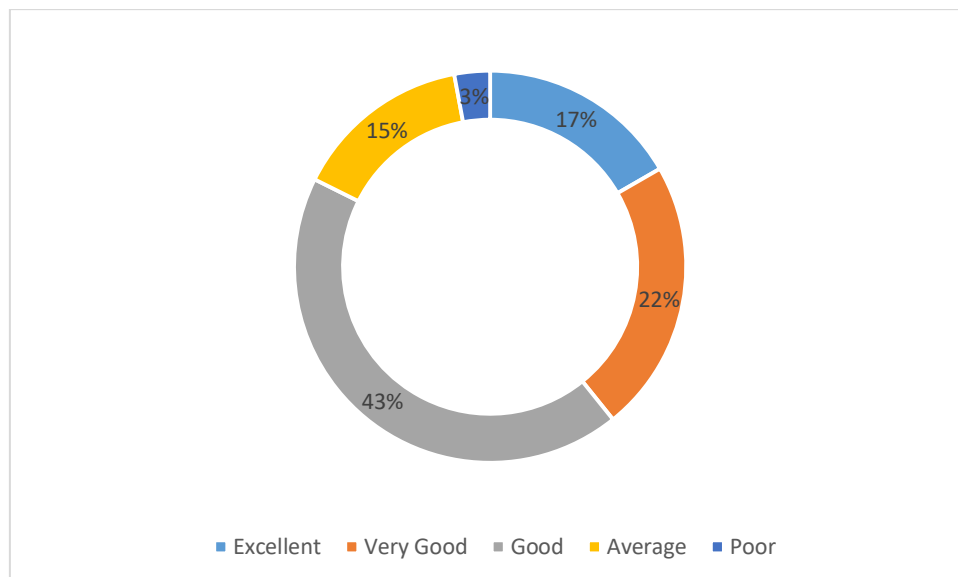

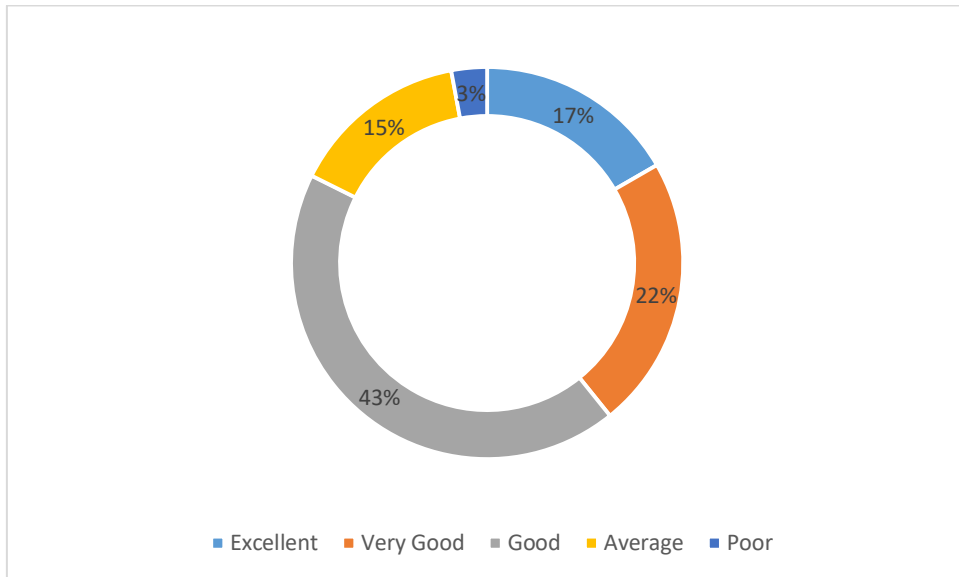
